### The Mission

*Outfitters is a Christian service that exists to provide new and quality used, in-style clothing to low-income children in South Madison County.*

### Outfitters' Service

Outfitters, a nonprofit store set up like a boutique, provides low income families the opportunity to obtain quality, in-style clothing, free of charge. Eligible children can come in twice a year and choose a week's worth of clothing\* – 5 pants/shorts, 6 tops, 7 pairs of underwear and socks, a jacket, a dress or skirt set and a \$25 shoe voucher to Kohls or Shoe Carnival. For privacy, shopping visits are by appointment only.

\*Clothing selections are based on availability. Socks, underwear and shoe vouchers are available during Fall shopping only.

### Eligible Children

- Children participating in the free lunch program
- School-aged children that are referred by:
  - A teacher, administrator, guidance counselor, or social worker
  - A pastor, priest, or rabbi
  - A social worker or caseworker at a social services agency
- Families with emergency needs, such as a family crisis, fire, flood or other disaster

### To Set Up An Appointment
